Chaperones and Volunteers:

If you want to accompany your child on a future field trip as a volunteer or chaperone, you MUST have prior approval from the Central Office of OCSU.

Over the summer is a great time to get the background check and fingerprint requirement started prior to the 2017 - 2018 school year. Given the length of time (expected wait time is 4 weeks to 3 months) it takes to get the results back, having the entire summer to get the results returned to Central Office gives volunteers and chaperones the chance to be active at the start of the school year.

As long as the person, who has been approved, stays active every school year, the approval is valid while the student is enrolled in an OCSU school.

The process begins at the Central Office of OCSU at the COFEC building in Barton (130 Kinsey Road ... phone number ... 525-1209 ext. 134) with Lisa Worden (or Crista Perkins). Summer hours are 7 AM – 3 PM.

Please call first to be sure someone is available to help you.

You will need to bring with you ... two pieces of identification (at least one being a photo ID) as well as exact change, check, or money order for \$16.50 payable to OCSU.

Simultaneously, you should make an appointment at the Orleans Sheriff's Department (located at: 5578 US Route 5 Derby, VT ... Phone: (802) 334-3333). You will need to bring exact change or check/money order for \$25, the form you received from Central Office, and two forms of government issued id (one must be a photo – the other can be your social security card, passport or work or school id). Make check or money order payable to the Orleans County Sheriff's Department. You can also call and go to the town police in St. Johnsbury or Morrisville. It does not seem to be faster regardless of where you have your prints done. The sheriff's office uses ink whereas St J. uses a computer scan. It is the same cost regardless of where you go.
